End-of-life care

We believe everyone deserves dignity, respect and compassionate support as they approach the end of their life. At Tabley House, we provide sensitive, person-centred care for both residents and their loved ones.

We understand that this can be a difficult and emotional time. Our dedicated facilities allow families to stay close, supporting them to spend meaningful time together. We also work closely with local hospices to ensure care is co-ordinated and responsive.

Our approach to care includes:

- > Recognising when someone may be approaching the end of their life, and responding promptly and appropriately
- > Communicating clearly with the resident, their family and all those involved in their care
- > Involving the resident and those important to them in decisions about care and treatment
- > Supporting the needs of family members and loved ones
- > Providing a personalised care plan that supports:
 - Food and drink
 - Symptom management
 - Emotional and psychological wellbeing
 - Spiritual needs

Life at Tabley House

What are the rooms like?

Each bedroom at Tabley House is unique, with its own character and charm shaped by personal belongings and decorations.

All rooms are comfortably and thoughtfully furnished.

We offer a range of options, including single rooms and flexible spaces for those who may wish to share with a friend or loved one.



When can family and friends visit?

There is a real family feel at Tabley House and visitors are warmly welcomed. To allow residents to enjoy mealtimes, we have some protected times during the day, but outside of this, visitors are free to come and go. Friends, families and loved ones are encouraged to join in all activities and become part of life at Tabley House.

What is there to do?

Residents are supported to spend their time in a way that suits them. They are involved in choosing activities and events, based on their interests and preferences.

We work with residents and their loved ones to develop a personalised approach to each day, balancing care needs with hobbies and routines.

Our recreation team organises a wide range of activities, including arts, games, shopping trips and more. We also welcome visiting professionals for entertainment and special events.

We can support individuals throughout their care journey, adapting care as needs change while maintaining dignity, comfort and continuity.

We are happy to meet with individuals and families before moving in, to ensure we can provide the right level of care and support.

What are the meals like?

We offer a range of freshly prepared, nutritious meals, served in our bright and welcoming dining room. Residents can also choose to have meals in their own rooms if preferred.

Our chef meets with residents when they arrive to understand their preferences and regularly reviews menus to ensure a good variety of meals.

We can cater for all dietary requirements, and refreshments are available throughout the day.





The history of Tabley House

Tabley House was designed in 1760 by the architect John Carr of York and is now a Grade I listed building. It is one of the finest examples of an 18th-century Palladian country house in Cheshire.

For over 700 years, the Tabley estate was home to the Leicester family, with the house at the heart of an estate that once spanned 6,000 acres.

The last member of the Leicester family to live at Tabley House was Lieutenant Colonel John Leicester Warren, who died in 1975. The following year, the estate, house and its collection of paintings, furniture and memorabilia were entrusted to the University of Manchester.

In the early 1990s, Cygnet worked in partnership with the University of Manchester to transform Tabley House into a nursing home. This unique setting retains many of its original features and historic artefacts, including those displayed in the on-site museum.
